## **Explanation of Abbreviations:**

Garadsil = human papilloma virus (HPV)

Hib = haemophilus influenzae type b

Hep A = hepatitis A virus

Hep B = hepatitis B virus

IPV = inactivated polio virus

Menactra = meningococcal (to prevent meningitis)

MMR = measles, mumps, rubella

Pentacel = DTaP, Hib, IPV

DTaP = diphtheria, tetanus, acellular pertussis (whooping cough)

Prevnar = pneumococcal virus (13 strains)
Rotateq = rotavirus (stomach virus)
Td = adult tetanus and diphtheria

TdaP = adult tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis Varicella = chicken pox virus

## **Immunization Policy:**

I believe immunizations are critical to your child's protection. Heritage Pediatrics requires up to date vaccines as provided by our vaccination schedules. I am happy to discuss with you the concerns you may have regarding vaccines or my recommended schedule. Though we can alter the schedule some, please know that it is in the best interest of your child and other children in my practice to vaccinate as close to the recommended schedule as possible. All vaccines, no matter the schedule selected, must be caught up by milestones at 2 years, 6 years and 14 years.
